

WNY & UB Recognized for Telemedicine IP Video Expertise

Our regional experience with high performance IP-video in telemedicine will be featured in an on-line roundtable discussion on June 6, hosted by the University of North Carolina. The roundtable series will focus on the effects of Internet technology on international music, home computing, medicine, and other areas of study. UNC is generally acknowledged as the North American hub of research and development work in the high quality IP-video early adopter community. They develop and manage the global multi-institutional Large Scale Video Network Prototype (LSVNP), an IP-video based collaboration support network of academic and research institutions. UB, ECMC, and the WNY-HPNVI are small grant holders and participants in the LSVNP. Our inclusion on the roundtable is based on our work on Extended Grand Rounds, our on- going global collaborative living-laboratory trial and demonstration.
